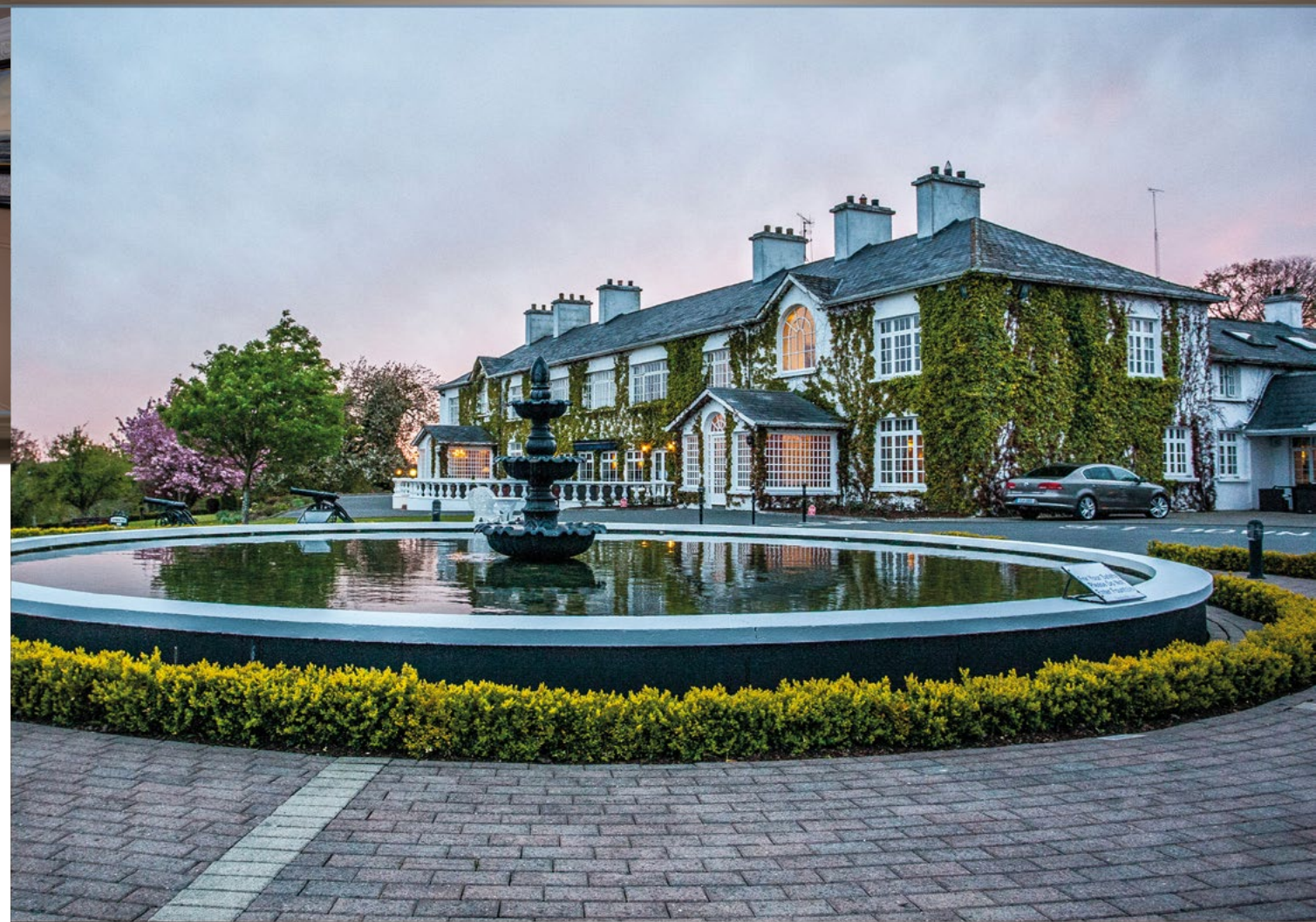
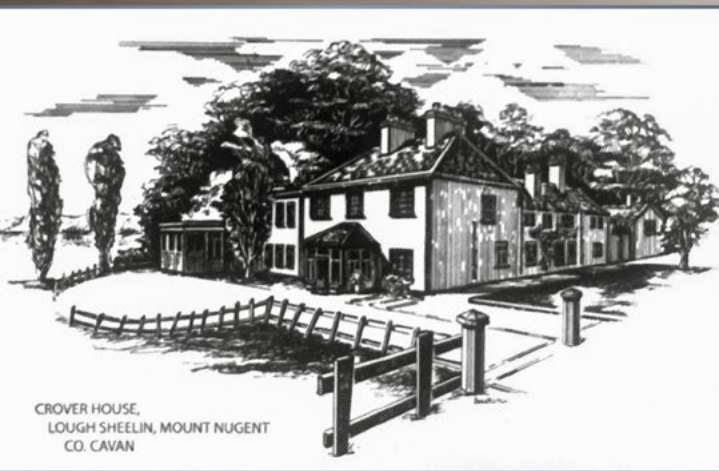




CROVER HOUSE

Endeavoring to make Crover House one of the finest hotels in Cavan, the O'Reilly's built an inspiring twenty-eight bedroom extension, a beautiful chalet overlooking the magnificent Lough Sheelin, as well as an executive golf course and clubhouse, creating a stately venue that delivers not only elegant accommodation and spectacular views of the Irish countryside, but also a peaceful location that offers tranquillity and serenity to its many visitors and guests.

GOLF

Crover House Golf Course enjoys a stunning setting, with beautiful views of Lough Sheelin. The course will test your golfing skills with its par 3's, which require an iron shot with pinpoint accuracy into the sand based greens, which are surrounded by deep bunkers. The greens have been built in accordance with USGA specification and standards.

The signature hole is a par 5 that measures 600 yards. Your tee-shot must be played with a draw up the right side with out of bounds all the way on the left side.
